Sub: Timely updating information on MIS portal in respect of AMRUT – Reg.

Sir/ Madam,

I am directed to refer to this Ministry's D.O. letter of even number dated 03.11.2017 on the above mentioned subject wherein the importance of feeding data pertaining to the Mission cities covered under AMRUT on the MIS portal and updating it regularly was emphasized upon. Accordingly, State/UT Governments were requested to coordinate with all Mission cities covered in their respective State/UT and update the city level details on a monthly basis. This would enable the Ministry to continuously monitor and evaluate the physical and financial progress made by the State/ULBs/implementing agencies under AMRUT and would reflect the progress of the Mission on an updated basis. However, it has been noticed that while certain States/UTs are not updating the city level details on MIS portal regularly, other States/UTs are facing difficulties in updating the details.

- 2. Further, certain observations related to the project details entered by the States/UTs in the MIS portal have also come to the forefront. It is being observed that in many cases, the States/UTs have named the projects either incorrectly or arbitrarily. In some cases, repetition of projects is observed. On the contrary, certain States/UTs are yet to upload the details of all projects approved in the SAAPs. In a few other cases, there is a wide variation in the total cost/number of projects mentioned in the portal and the SAAPs as approved by the Ministry. Under AMRUT, concerned State/UT have been entrusted with the authority and responsibility of feeding and verifying the data on the portal on a regular basis. It is therefore requested that State Mission Director (AMRUT) may kindly verify the project-related data pertaining to their State/UT and also update it on a monthly basis.
- 3. Keeping in view the importance of maintaining and updating the MIS portal on a regular basis for proper monitoring of the Mission, it has been decided that in addition to the PMU (AMRUT) team, two officers of this Ministry viz Ms. Reema Jain and Ms. Neha Singh, Assistant Directors in the

Ministry, will act as Liaison Officers to coordinate with the Mission Directors of the concerned State/UT in order to facilitate the monthly updation of details related to the projects as well as the Mission cities on the MIS portal of AMRUT. The list of the States/UTs allocated to each of these officers have been attached at annexure. The States/UTs are requested to extend full cooperation in this regard and help in updating the MIS on regular basis besides improving the quality of the data.
